**RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
TO VACATE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF 14TH STREET, BETWEEN PORTOLA
& PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE IN THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond as follows:

Section 1. It is the intention of the Council of the City of Richmond to order the street vacation of a portion of 14th Street, between Portola Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue, in the City of Richmond, County of Contra Costa, State of California, more particularly described in the Legal Description (Exhibit "A") and (Exhibit "B") attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The portion of said street vacation which the Council of the City of Richmond intends to approve for vacation and abandonment is shown and delineated upon a map entitled "EXHIBIT "B" STREET VACATION MAP: PORTION OF 14TH STREET TO BE VACATED FOR S.F.B.A.R.T.D." now on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Richmond to which reference is hereby made for all particulars of said street.

Section 3. Tuesday, the 19th day of May, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City of Richmond, City Hall, Richmond, California is hereby fixed as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed easement vacation of said portion of said street.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to cause to be posted conspicuously along the line of said portion of said right-of-way to be vacated and abandon notices entitled "NOTICE OF STREET VACATION" which notices shall state the time and place of said hearing thereon. Said notices shall be posted not more than three hundred feet (300') apart and at least three (3) of said notices shall be posted at the said street for the public notification about the public right-of-way proposed to be vacated and abandoned; that the Council has elected and does hereby elect to take proceedings for the public street vacation and closing of said portion of said street under the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California that no portion of said street to be closed and vacated in these proceedings is a state highway.

Section 5. This resolution of intention, upon approval shall be printed and published in the EAST BAY TIMES, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Richmond.
