**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE CONTRA COSTA  
COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS IN  
AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$71,200 FOR THE RECREATION COMPLEX  
SOCIAL HALL FLOOR REPLACEMENT AND PAINTING PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Contra Costa County (“CCC”) issued a Notice of Funding Availability (“NOFA”) on October 17, 2018 for the Fiscal Year 2019/20 Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) Program grant funds to benefit low income residents or communities of Contra Costa County Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond is a municipal corporation and a charter city applied and was awarded the CDBG Program grant for the Recreation Complex Social Hall floor replacement and painting project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond has received and accepted the Agenda Report regarding this Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the City Council of the City of Richmond finds the above recitals accurate and have served together with the Agenda Report as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the City of Richmond hereby agrees to use the CDBG Program funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application as approved by CCC and in accordance with Program Regulations.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, The City Council authorizes the City Manager or their designee to execute in the name of the City of Richmond, the Project Agreement, and all other documents required by CCC for participation in the CDBG Program, and any amendments thereto and accept and appropriate the grant funds.
