

RESOLUTION NO. 08-28

RESOLUTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE RICHMOND COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY BOARD AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BAY AREA AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT (“BAAQMD”) TRANSPORTATION FUND FOR THE CLEAN AIR (“TFCA”) REGIONAL FUND PROGRAM FOR GRANT FUNDING OF PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON NEVIN AVENUE FROM 19th STREET EASTWARD TO 27th STREET.

WHEREAS, The Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency (“AGENCY”) is responsible for administering the effective Redevelopment Plans within the City, including the Amended and Restated Redevelopment Plans for Project Areas No. 10-A (Downtown) and 10-B (Nevin), adopted by Ordinance No. 22-99, dated July 13, 1999 and Ordinance No. 29-05, dated July 12, 2005, respectively, in accordance with the California Redevelopment Law (Collectively, the “Redevelopment Plans”); and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plans authorize the AGENCY to cause the installation of pedestrian improvements under the “Public Improvements” program area; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plans also authorize the AGENCY to utilize grant funds that may become available to implement the Redevelopment Plans.

WHEREAS, BAAQMD has issued a call for projects for TFCA Regional Fund Program grants, including Smart Growth/Traffic Calming as eligible project types.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency Board authorize the Executive Director to submit an application to the BAAQMD TFCA Regional Fund Program for grant funding of pedestrian improvements on Nevin Avenue from 19th Street eastward to 27th Street.
