

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-07**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE RICHMOND COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY BOARD AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH AMERINATIONAL COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC. FOR FINANCIAL LOAN SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY-FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$7,500).**

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**WHEREAS** the Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency is administering a Home Owners Assistance Center as part of the City's Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) under the United States Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and

**WHEREAS** there exists a contract with Amerinational Community Services, Inc., to provide loan servicing for the Homeowners Assistance Center Programs; and

**WHEREAS** it is necessary to increase the contract amount from \$49,490 to \$56,990 due to an expanded number of loans serviced.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by members of the Richmond Community Redevelopment Agency Board that they authorize the Executive Director to amend the contract with Amerinational Community Services, Inc. for an additional \$7,500. This amendment will increase the total contract amount from \$49,490 to \$56,990.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Executive Director is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver such other documents and to do such acts as may be deemed necessary or appropriate to accomplish the intentions of this resolution.
