

ORDINANCE NO. 01-18 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AMENDING SECTIONS 3.50.030 AND 3.50.040 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND. THIS AMENDMENT CHANGES THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS AND MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL TIMEFRAME FOR COMMISSION ON AGING MEMBERS

The City Council of the City of Richmond do ordain as follows:

Section I. Amendment of Section 3.50.030

Section 3.50.030 of the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond is hereby amended to read as follows:

“3.50.030. Appointment and qualifications of members.

The commission shall consist of thirteen members who shall not be officers or employees of the City and who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the concurrence of the City Council. All members of the commission shall be at least fifty-five years old and shall reside in West Contra Costa County which shall include areas within the West Contra Costa Unified School District boundaries. The membership must be maintained at all times at a ratio of 70% Richmond residents and 30% non-residents. All vacancies on the commission shall be filled by appointment by the City Council for the unexpired term of the appointee’s predecessor.”

Section II. Amendment of Section 3.50.040

Section 3.50.040 of the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond is hereby amended to read as follows:

“3.50.040. Terms of Office.

The term of each member of the commission shall be for four years. Each member may serve an unlimited number of consecutive terms.”

Section III. Effective Date. This Ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.

First read at a regular meeting of the Council of the City of Richmond held December 19, 2017, and finally passed and adopted at a regular meeting thereof held January 16, 2018, by the following vote:


